Formed 8th January 1945 at Zeals by redesignating an element of 107 Operational Training Unit.

Formed 31st January 1944 at Willingdon Airport, New Delhi, India by redesignating the Air Command Southeast Asia Communication Unit.

Disbanded 30th September 1946 at Changi, Singapore, to become the Air Command Far East Air Headquarters Malaya Communication Squadron.
